Classes for September 2025



New classes will be shared after phonics screening has taken place next week. Some children can find the information about moving onto new teachers a little unsettling, so we have decided to wait until all assessments have taken place before the information about their new teachers is shared with them. Staffing in school remains stable.

Transition Days



Current Reception and Year 1 children will be spending two days in their new classes on Monday 30th June and Tuesday 1st July. This is a very important time for children to get to know their new teacher and environment.

Current Nursery children will be spending the day in Reception on Tuesday 1st July.

Current Year 2 children's SMSG transition days are Monday 30th June and Monday 7th July. Current Year 2 children's Bushfield transition day is Tuesday 1ST July (am only) - Children should return to RSS for their afternoon session. When current Year 2 children are not having transition time, they should still attend school and meet on our KS1 playground at 8:30am and be collected at 3:05pm.

Entrance and exits into school on the 30th June and 1st July:

Current Year 1 children should enter school using the Key Stage One gate at 8:30am where they will be greeted by their new teachers on the Key Stage One playground.

Please collect these children from the Key Stage One playground at 3:00pm.

Current Reception children should enter school using the Key Stage One gate at **8:40am** where they will be greeted by their new teachers on the Key Stage One playground.

Please collect these children from the Key Stage One playground at 3:05pm.

Nursery times, entrance and exits remain unaltered for these days. We take Nursery children into Reception once they have entered Nursery on Tuesday 1st July.

Hogshaw Farm Trip (Reception) – 5th June

Hogshaw Farm believes in the importance of learning through first-hand experience of their natural world and the great outdoors. We will learning about the different animals that live on a farm and identifying features of the countryside. We will also be having a picnic!





World Oceans Day - 2025 Theme - Sustaining What Sustains Us!

Sunday 8th June (being held in school on Friday 6th June) We will be revisiting our learning about the ocean names and the fact that nearly ¾ of our planet's surface is covered by water. We will learn that the oceans are a very important part of our world. The ocean is our source of life. It supports humans and every other living creature on Earth. At least half of the world's oxygen is produced by the oceans and that the oceans absorb about 93% of the extra heat from global warming.

Phonics Screening Check – w/c 9th June

The Phonics Screening Check will be taken by children in Year 1 on a one-to-one basis with a teacher they know well. During the Phonics Screening Check, children are asked to read (decode) 40 words. These words are a mixture of real words and pseudo-words. Pseudo-words (alien/nonsense) are included to ensure that children are using their decoding skills and not just relying on their memory of words they've read before.

Healthy Eating Week – 9th – 13th June

Healthy Eating Week 2025 is taking place from $9^{th} - 13^{th}$ June and has the theme "Find your healthier you". We will be thinking about: Know the facts about healthy food choices, what are healthier choices, how to make better choices, as well as keeping moving, promoting the importance of being active for health.



World Music Day – Saturday 21st June (being celebrated in school on the 18th June)

We will be celebrating World Music Day in school by watching and listening to music as well as learning songs associated with our summer units of work.

Year 2 children will be taking part in the Milton Keynes Key Stage One Music Festival on the morning of Wednesday 18th June. Further details will be sent to Year 2 families.

Dress for Dinners – Friday 20th June

Class Concerts – Wednesday 2nd July (Nursery) and Tuesday 24th June (Year 1)

Nursery and Year 1 concerts will be taking place on the dates above. Nursery's performance (weather permitting) will take place on the Key Stage One playground.

If because of rain the concert moves into the school hall, places will then be limited to 2 per family – younger siblings may sit on parents' laps.

Year 1 will perform in the school hall on Tuesday 24th June at 2.15pm. Places are limited to 2 per family.

Year 2 Milton Keynes Museum Trip – 9th July

We are taking Year 2 chldren to Milton Keynes Museum on 9th July. The trip will be based on Victorians lives. On the visit the children will learn all about Victorian homes and way of life and compare them to life in modern day. They will take part in 3 activities - tour of the parlour and servants' room, tour of the Victorian laundry and kitchen, tour of Victorian cottage (including privy and garden weather permitting). In the afternoon they will look at a Victorian street with shops, schoolroom and different forms of transport.
