Educational Visits

Each year group plans an educational visit each year as a stimulus for work back at school. Visits include Sulgrave Manor, Whipsnade Zoo and Woodside Farm. Parents are increasingly opting out of contributing to the costs of these visits. Unfortunately visits are becoming unsustainable at a time of diminishing budgets. A shortfall in visit funds means that we have to use money planned for books and curriculum resources.

We are extremely lucky to be situated in the heart of Stony Stratford as our curriculum benefits from a wealth of community support. This term we have benefitted from gardening support from Stony in Bloom and reading support from Friends of Stony Stratford Library.

Year 2 had a very successful visit to St Mary's and St Giles' Church where they had a music session. Father Benjamin recently visited us to join in with an assembly and has a few further visits planned this term.
