Is your child eligible for Pupil Premium?

Please, please continue to apply for Pupil Premium (the old free school meals grant) if you are eligible. This money has a significant impact on our funding. It allows us to offer the eligible children free clubs, including infant strings, and visits. It also ensures that we can maintain Reading Recovery and Numbers Counts provision for those children who need it. This provision impacts on learning for all children; the pitch of teaching is raised across classes as a result of closing the gap in attainment.
